## Registration and Financial Aid for Summer 2016

Students need to submit an application if they want to be considered for financial aid for the summer semester. The application for Summer 2015-2016 is available at: <http://www.udmercy.edu/apply/financial-aid/forms/2015-2016/2015-16%20Summer%20App.pdf>

Students should be aware that their summer financial aid could vary based on the summer session(s) they choose to enroll in.

Students who are graduating during Summer 2016 and who take out loans during the summer, will have their loans prorated based on the number of summer credits for which they enroll.

## Degree Evaluation in TitanConnect

Degree Evaluation is a helpful on-line tool for students to see all their program requirements and track what is met/unmet towards successful completion. Encourage students to run a Degree Evaluation *prior* to registration (to see what they still need) and *after* registration (to confirm that their scheduled courses are fulfilling program requirements). ## Transfer Credit Evaluation

Transfer credits are typically posted within one to two weeks after a transfer student has been admitted. If you set an appointment with a new transfer advisee and do not see credits in TitanConnect - Academic History, please contact the Transfer Team at 313-993-1940. Your advisee's transfer credit evaluation will be prioritized so that you will have optimal information prior to your academic advising session with a new student.

## Post Degree students – Core Curriculum often Waived

Policy on when to waive UDM's Core Curriculum for post degree students (UG students with a prior bachelor's degree): *If the first baccalaureate degree was earned at an accredited institution and included a core curriculum/ general education component, there are no core curriculum requirements for the second baccalaureate degree.*

However, major/program requirements that are also used to fulfill Core Curriculum requirements are not waived. To adjust a Degree Evaluation to reflect a waived Core, contact the Transfer Team (see contacts above).
